

## ELECTION DAY: NOVEMBER 6TH, 2018

### REGISTER TO VOTE:

To vote early in Iowa, fill out a voter registration form! That form can be found at:

You can complete a voter registration form by going to the Johnson County Auditor's Office before October 27th, too. Or you can register at the polls on Election Day.

### WHERE TO VOTE:

There will be early voting polls at the Iowa Memorial Union on October 23-25 from 9 AM - 3 PM. Polls will be on the ground floor. The University of Iowa Hospital & Clinics will have early voting polls on October 24-26 from 10 AM - 4 PM.

### DO I NEED AN ID?

Yes! You will be asked to show one of the following: Iowa Driver's License, Iowa Non-Operator's ID, U.S. Passport, Military ID, Veteran's ID, or Voter ID Card.

If you don't have any of those, don't worry! You may sign an oath verifying your identity and then cast a regular ballot.
